



## “THE LAST GOODBYE” SESSION 2 of 3 TEACHER NOTES

### Suggested 1 hour session (plus individual assignment):

5 minutes: Students watch video

30 minutes: Students research the Europe-based stories on the World War 1 Explorer, watch the linked videos, and note their 20 or so descriptive/ feelings words

25 minutes: Share these words to a group word cloud (via GoogleJam if available), making the 5 words most important to them larger, and sharing their reasons why (via audio recording or in writing).

Assessment: Ask your family about any relatives that either fought in or were affected by WW1?

*Students will need access to good strength broadband, and an up-to-date version of a common desktop browser, ideally Chrome or Firefox. The resource does support most common current iOS and Android mobile devices, although the controls will be different.*
