Homes: Then and Now (KS1)

Explore a fantastic example of a Victorian house and investigate the people who lived there and the different jobs they did. This will be done through role play: deciding which artefacts would have belonged to a maid, a gardener, Julia Margaret Cameron, her husband and one of her children. Pupils will also think about how household items have changed by placing artefacts on a timeline and completing a trail around the house.

Curriculum Links: History, Science & English

Julia Margaret Cameron and the Victorians (KS1 & KS2)

Pupils will learn about the pioneer Victorian photographer, Julia Margaret Cameron, the famous people she photographed and the house she lived in through a museum trail. Pupils will create a pop-up Victorian museum using a wide range of original artefacts to bring to life the people who lived in the house. They will also find out about links to Dimbola and Alice in Wonderland.
