

## The Earth Museum World War 1: Creating Our Explorer Map

### Lesson Plan 4

This lesson will be led remotely by TEM.

Today we are going to review all that we have learnt about WW1 personal stories over the last 3 weeks and create our own Explorer map on The Earth Museum.

#### Exercise 1: Haslar Royal Naval Cemetery

Teacher notes.

*30 minutes*

Each student will choose one personal story we looked at during the field trip and write a short note to the person who died describing what you would like to say to them if they were still here.

#### Exercise 2: Choosing stories from the WW1 Explorer to include in our map

Teacher notes.

*20 minutes*

Students will re-visit the WW1 Explorer and each choose two stories they would like to include on our map. Provide the title name of the story on a shared spreadsheet.

Review spreadsheet from Lesson 2 about Lee-on-the-Solent

Create and publish map in real time

#### Exercise 4: Review Learning

*Extension activity if people finish early for Exercise 1 and 2*
