Lesson Plan 6: Rapa Nui Migration Stories

Learning aims

- To explore stories of migration relating to Rapa Nui
- To appreciate how these stories connect Rapa Nui with global histories
- To reflect on experiences of migration and to translate these into opportunities for creative inspiration and expression

Rapa Nui migration stories

- Individual work (30 minutes)
 - Explore a selection of Rapa Nui Migration Stories on the following map <https://createearthmuseum.com/explorers/rapa-nui-easter-island-migration-stories>
 - Find all 22 stories around the world and write down the countries they relate to in your exercise book
- Working in pairs (25 minutes and extended lesson)
 - Choose one story between you
 - Discuss what you think it would have been like to be a character in the story
 - One person – write 50 words in the character’s first person about this story
 - One of you imagine you are making a 30 second film about it – what images would you use to capture this story frame by frame? What kind of music would you have as background?
 - Prepare a class PowerPoint with each group’s 50 words, images and music ideas
