Learning aims

- To recap on learning about Rapa Nui Migration stories, spreadsheets, data, GIS and coordinates
- To explore world stories of migration relating to the Isle of Wight
- To appreciate how these stories connect Isle of Wight with global histories
- To reflect on experiences of migration and to translate these into opportunities for creative inspiration and expression
- To present student stories on a digital map collaboratively using Create The Earth Museum
- To practice using spreadsheets, data, GIS and coordinates
